No advanced reservation required. Automated kiosk pick up is not available for Appreciation Day tickets - you must visit a ticket window. All guests will be required to have a Catamount RFID Card. If a guest does not already have a card, one needs to be purchased at time of redemption for \$5.00. This reloadable card is a one-time purchase per individual and valid at both Catamount and Berkshire East Mountain Resort. Cards can be reused and reloaded over multiple seasons.
